Add a little Photoshop to your skill set. Follow along with this quick technique that will show you how to bring out the best in any photograph using the Camera RAW Filter.



1. Download the following asset

Locate the following image on Adobe Stock and download a preview image to your computer.

Adobe Stock image: Family in living room... by fizkess



2. Open the JPEG from Adobe Stock in Photoshop

- Locate the Layers panel. If you do not see it on screen, Choose Layers from the Windows menu:
- Select the Background layer in the Layers panel
- Choose Convert for Smart Filters form the Filter menu

This will convert the layer into a Smart Object, which will allow us to apply non-destructive edits to the image.



3. Apply the Camera RAW Filter to your image

With the new Smart Object layer selected in the Layers panel, choose Camera RAW Filter from the Filter menu, and set the following values:

Exposure 0.9
Highlights -100.0
Shadows 60.0
Whites -100.0
Clarity 27.0
Vibrance 15.0

4. Prepare to be amazed with your new image

The Camera RAW Filter gives you the power to reveal lost details in the darkest areas of your photos — while simultaneously allowing you to adjust the exposure, remove atmospheric haze, and apply vibrance to the colors.
