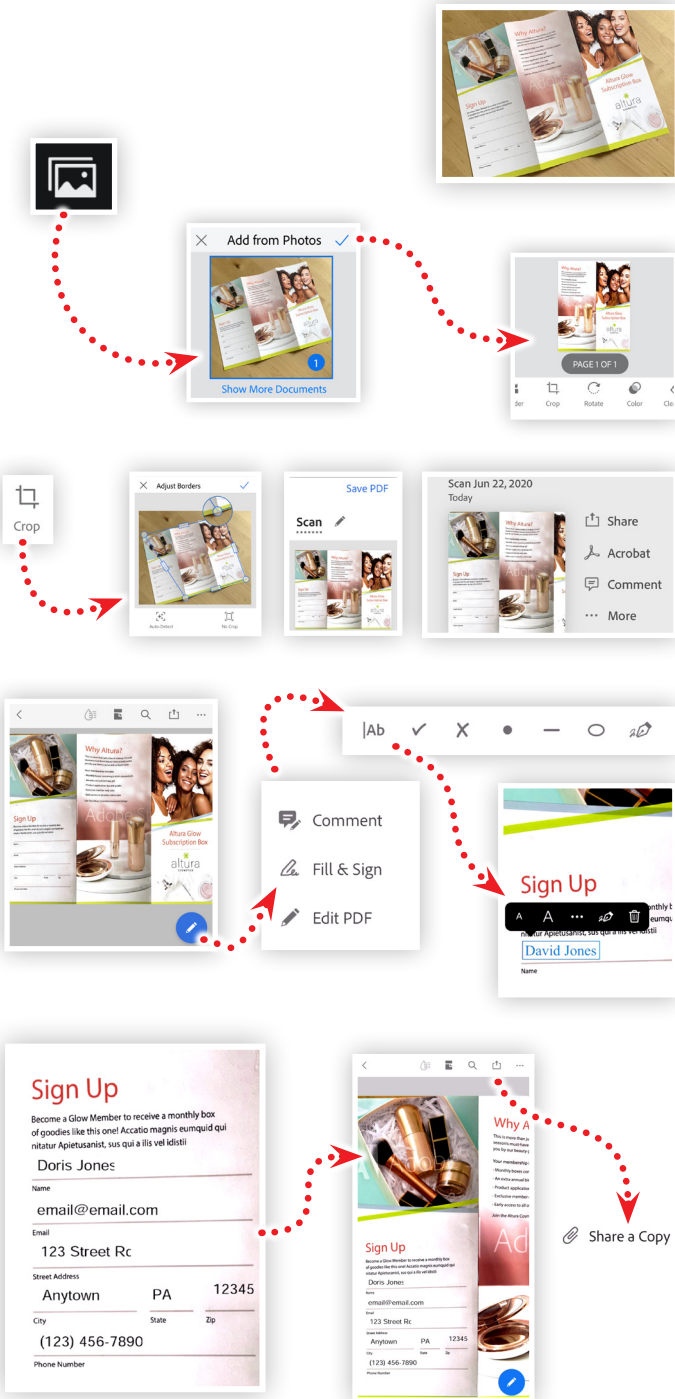

Scan, Share, and Review PDFs with Creative Cloud

Learn to capture, crop, and convert a paper form into a fully functional PDF file using Adobe Scan and Document Cloud — then use Acrobat to fill, sign, and share your info.



1. Download the following asset

Download the following assets save them to a location that you can access on your mobile device that is currently running

Adobe Acrobat & Adobe Scan.

2. Load photo of a brochure into Adobe Scan

Launch the Adobe Scan app on your mobile device and tap the load image icon, and then locate the brochure photo in your photo library. Once selected, tap on the check mark in the upper-right corner to load the image into Adobe Scan.

3. Crop, Adjust, and create a PDF

Tap on the Crop tool to adjust the capture area to include the entire brochure, then tap on the Save PDF link in the upper-right of the screen. Next, tap on Acrobat to send your new PDF file over to the Acrobat app

4. Fill out the form using Fill & Sign

Tap on the Edit button and then the Fill & Sign option, then:

- Tap on the text field tool
- Tap in the area where you'd write your name
- Type in your name
- Customize the size using the text size tools
- Tap on the remaining fields and enter in your information

5. Share your PDF

Once you have added your info to the form fields, tap the Done link in the upper-left of the screen. After reviewing your info, tap the Share button in the upper-right.

Finally, tap the Share a Copy button in the bottom-right of the Share screen to send a PDF that contains all of the information you entered using Fill & Sign.
