






Hybrid Image Delivery - Detail



Supported Configurations

Scenario	How It Works
Deliver BOTH images and video in production	 Videos - delivered and cached by CDN Images, video poster images - delivered via Adobe's WW data centers and cached by CDN
Deliver ONLY video in any environment (production, Dev, QE, Stage, etc)	 Videos - delivered and cached by CDN Video poster image - delivered by AEM publish instance
Delivery ONLY images in production	Images - delivered via Adobe's WW data centers and cached by CDN
Deliver ONLY images in pre- production (Dev, QE, Stage, etc.)	 Images - delivered through AEM publish node Since traffic is minimal, performance is not an issue Added benefit is secure preview of content before production launch
Asset Share (Download Dynamic image Renditions)	Dynamic Media generates image renditions on-the-fly without incurring any additional storage. Use Asset Share in conjunction with Dynamic Media to download image renditions for different formats, sizes, quality, etc.

- Distribution to Secondary Data Centers Asynchronously
- Independently Performance and Load Tested



AEM 6.1 Upgrade

- NPR-8956 Scalable Dynamic Media Hybrid Publishing
 - Commons Interest FP for all AEM 6.1 Dynamic Media customers
 - Provides AEM 6.2 replication improvements to AEM 6.1 customers
- Migration Required
 - File layout in delivery changed which requires migration
 - No downtime in delivery during migration
 - Scheduled downtime in replication service during migration
 - Dry-run done by QE before NPR-8956 is released
