Q & A from AEM GEM session Dec 3, 2014 – Machine Translation

- Q. If we are using launches (http://docs.adobe.com/docs/en/cq/current/wcm/launches.html) to work on future release. Can we use machine translation for this also?
 - A. Yes, you can run Machine translation workflow on Launches content as well. It may not be hooked up with UI though.
 - REPLY: If does not appear in UI How do make promote part of launch promote?
 - A. You can use Launches UI to do the same. Let me clarify: my comment about UI was limited to the Languages section of the References Tab.
- Q. Is translated content happens on-demand clicking on translate button Or translated content stored somewhere & just displayed clicking translate button?
 - A. You can configure persistence options. We provide three options out of the box:
 - a) Translate contributions on user request and persist thereafter
 - b) Automatically translate contributions in all supported languages, as soon as a contribution is made
 - c) Do not persist translations
- Q. How do you persist, at a high level?
 - A. We store translations in the configured backend (JCR, MongoDB, Cloud Storage) as child of contribution. We create a new translation node and save translations in specific languages under a language specific nodes. For example, a French translation is stored as <comment node path>/translation/fr
